Statistics

All connections on port 80

```
$ netstat -anp | grep :80
```

Netstat Help

```
$ netstat -h
```

<code>netstat -ltunp</code>	All Listening ports

<code>netstat -a</code>	All connections
-------------------------	-----------------

<code>netstat -at</code>	All TCP connections

<code>netstat -au</code>	All UDP connections
--------------------------	---------------------

Statistics

<code>netstat -s</code>	Display statistics
-------------------------	--------------------

<code>netstat -st</code>	Display TCP statistics
--------------------------	------------------------

<code>netstat -su</code>	Display UDP statistics

Networks

<code>netstat -i</code>	Show network interfaces
-------------------------	-------------------------

<code>netstat -ie</code>	Show network interfaces extended info

Routing

<code>netstat -r</code>	Show routing table
-------------------------	--------------------

<code>netstat -rn</code>	Show routing table, don't resolve hosts
